

CHARGING POLICY

All that is required to meet the demands of the school curriculum is provided for out of the school budget.

Activities/experiences that we feel will be of value to our students, above and beyond the curricular needs are provided **free of any charge for the involvement of the staff**, but some or all of the cost has to be deferred to parents. These activities include: residentials (usually at Dolcorsllwyn Hall), holidays (ski-trips etc.), outings (such as the "reward" trips to Morecambe), Musical Lessons to pupils not on FSM, and sports teams away fixtures.

No pupil is disbarred from taking part in any Kirkby High School activity, taking place during the normal school hours, by inability to pay. It must be remembered, however, that to make this promise good we are heavily dependent on the generosity of our community and its support for our fund raising activities.

No extra-curricular activity, where a contribution from parents is requested, can proceed unless the necessary funding is provided from non-public sources. This should not stop parents who have genuine financial difficulty from letting their son/daughter take part. Thanks to the generosity and commitment of parents and friends over the years we can always help where real need exists.

Let your children take part in the extra-curricular provision, contribute what you can, but let us know if there is a difficulty.
