Mini Scripts—Layout of a Script

Stage Directions should be acted out not read aloud.

[Stage directions in brackets and/or italics.]

Character: The lines to be read out!

Character 2: Lines for character 2!

On the left is the name of the character who performs the line/s next to it.

The lines to be performed on stage

Drama and Acting Techniques

Still Image	A frozen picture that captures a scene on stage
Direct Address	The actor breaks the forth wall to speak directly to the audience
Centre of Leadership	Using a part of the body to physically become a character
Tension	How sound and silence can build tension for an audience
Projection	Ensuring the audience can clearly hear your vocal work
