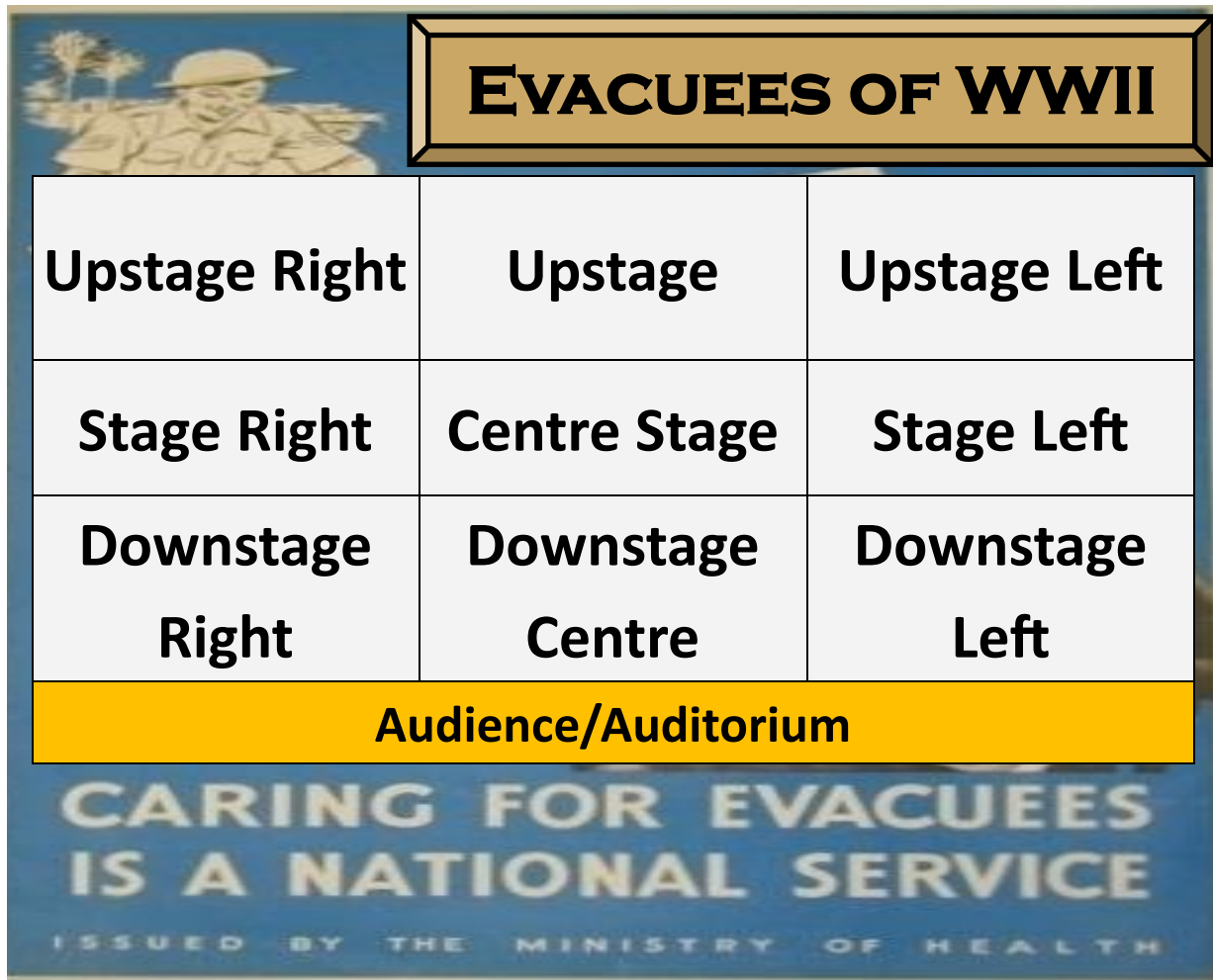

Drama and Acting Techniques

Auditorium	The area of a theatre where the audience sits
Thoughts In Head	When an actor speaks the thoughts of another actor's character
Thought Track	When an actor speaks out loud their character's thoughts
Cross Cutting	Using still image and action to cut between 2 scenes on 2 sides of the stage
Juxtaposition	Presenting two contrasting scenes side by side for an audience to compare
Historical/Period Drama	Drama which is set in a past time period
Choice of Language	Ensure language fits the period in which the drama is set
