Dear Parent/Carer,

Happy New Year. I am writing this letter in order to keep you up to date with plans for the coming days but, as we are all aware, there could be new government announcements at any time. I will contact you again if there are further changes.

This plan is in response to the government announcement made on 30th December 2020 stating that year 11 students will not return to school until Monday 11th January and all other year groups will return on Monday 18th January. This excludes students whose parents are critical workers or students who are classed as vulnerable. Parents who have expressed an interest in sending their child to school due to falling into these categories have been contacted today to confirm the arrangements.

Our aim is to help your child to continue their learning journey during this time, so they are not disadvantaged by the current situation when they return to school. It is therefore essential that your child attends all their Microsoft Teams live lessons described below. Registers will be taken for every lesson and parents will be contacted if students do not access their lessons online. If your child is unwell and therefore unable to attend the live lessons, please contact school and report the sickness in the usual way.

Tuesday 5th January

Staff training day- Pre-prepared work will be set on Microsoft Teams for all year groups.

Wednesday 6th January onwards

Live lessons will take place on Microsoft Teams following your child's usual school timetable. A copy of this timetable will be posted out to KS3 today. All KS4 have a copy of their timetable in their lanyard.

Monday 18th January

Years 7 to 10 return to school
