Key Terms

Disability *a physical or mental condition that limits a person's movements, senses, or activities*

Discrimination *the unjust or prejudicial treatment of different categories of people, especially on the grounds of race, age, sex, or disability. The word can also mean knowing the difference between right and wrong.*

Empathy *the ability to understand and share the feelings of another (person, character etc)*

Anti-Social Behaviour *'behaviour by a person which causes, or is likely to cause, harassment, alarm or distress to persons not of the same household as the person'*
