Key Terms

Prejudice preconceived ideas not based on reason or actual experience; "*prejudice against people from different backgrounds*"

Discrimination the unjust or prejudicial treatment of different categories of people, especially on the grounds of race, age, sex, or disability.

Ableism discrimination and social prejudice against people with disabilities or who are perceived to be disabled.

Anti-Semitism hostility to - or prejudice against - Jewish people

Holocaust destruction or slaughter on a mass scale, especially caused by fire or nuclear war.

Black Lives Matter (BLM) an international social movement, formed in the United States in 2013, dedicated to fighting racism and anti-Black violence, especially in the form of police brutality.
