How to change the language in the app

Introduction

Follow the below instructions to change the language settings.

- 1. Step 1 shows how to change the settings from the login page

- 3. Step 3 changing the language of content created by the school

You may or may not be aware that Step 1 & 2 have always been available, this pilot is specifically testing Step 3. However, we have included all steps for your reference and awareness.




Look out for this language icon - where you see this icon you can click to change language. Examples can be found in the steps below.



2) Select your preferred language.




3) This will change how buttons are labelled in the app.




STEP 2: Changing the language of the app once logged in


1) Open the menu.




2) Tap **App Settings**.




3) Tap Language.




4) Tap English (British).



5) Select your preferred language.






STEP 3: Changing the language of content created by the school


1) Open the menu.




2) Tap App Settings.




3) Tap Language.




4) Tap No Choice.




5) Select your preferred language.
