Year 10 Mock GCSE Examinations: Monday 24th June – Wednesday 10th July

As part of our programme to prepare students for their examinations at the end of Year 11, we have scheduled a series of mock examinations for all year 10 students to take place over two weeks starting Monday 24th June until Wednesday 10th July. These mock examinations are designed to give students a realistic experience of an examination setting, and a chance to judge where they need to focus their efforts for the remainder of the academic year and into the beginning of Year 11.

A copy of the examination timetable is included along with an examinations handbook for both you and your child to read. This will provide any information you may need to know about the exams process in school. Please pay particular attention to the conduct during exams as failure to comply with the exam rules could result in disqualification.

Key details during the mock examinations

- Students must arrive to school no later than 8:45 am. It is vital that students are in on time as this could result in them missing out on their exam which would affect their final grade
- If your child is unable to attend an examination due to illness, please telephone the school as soon as possible following the normal absence procedure.
- Students must arrive fully equipped for their exam. We would expect your child to have at least one black pen, a pencil, a ruler and eraser
