Dear Parent / Carer,

The School Nursing Service provides health and wellbeing support to children and young people in Knowsley schools.

During year nine, we offer the opportunity for them to complete a short questionnaire about their health and wellbeing.

The questionnaire is private and confidential, and responses will be sent to the school nursing team via a secure email. All responses will then be triaged to identify any health and wellbeing concerns.

Following this, the team may contact you or arrange to see your child if they have requested to see a school nurse. In addition, any emerging themes from the questionnaires will be used to develop an individual public health plan for your child's school. The plan will support the delivery of health and wellbeing sessions.

Your child will be provided with the QR code and the list of websites below that they may find useful in relation to accessing free health and wellbeing support.
