September 2025 return

Year 7

The first day of the new school year is very important as Year 7 students will have their transition day where they will learn a lot about being a Kirkby High school student. Any absence from school will lead to gaps in their knowledge and this can cause major challenges at later stages.

The importance of attendance

Attendance to school is statutory, and parents/carers are expected to ensure that your child attends school every day. Kirkby High School continues to engage with families to ensure that you understand that all students must regularly attend school every day, aiming for a maximum of 4% absence for each child. The ideal is 0% absence.

Holidays during term time are not approved of and will likely lead to a fixed penalty notice. Any missed days leads to missed learning, and your child will miss key knowledge for future learning.

Arbor app

You will receive information about how to sign up to the school Arbor app. The app allows you to check your child's homework, attendance, rewards and behaviour. From January 2026, all messages and letters home will be sent through the Arbor app and not via text message. We expect that you download the app without delay. Please let school know if you change contact details so we can ensure you do not miss any key messages.

Uniform expectations

At Kirkby High School, we believe strongly that wearing our school uniform well and with pride contributes to the calm learning environment we all want for our children. It also promotes a sense of belonging to our school. In September, we will reinforce our high standards of uniform.

Under no circumstances can a student attend school wearing trainers. We will not be flexible on this. Please see the table below for a reminder of our uniform expectations and share this crucial information with your child. We appreciate your support with this.

Uniform rules that will be enforced from the start of the next academic year are:

We expect the following:

- Black blazer with badge
- Grey trousers / Grey skirt or slip worn to knee length or longer
- White shirt / White blouse
- School tie (must be tied at a sufficient length that shows the school badge)
- Grey school badged cardigan or school badged V neck jumper
- Plain black socks
- Black flat leather style shoes
- A sensible school bag large enough to carry A4 file

Please note the following:

- No trainers
- No extreme hairstyles
- No coats worn inside the building
- No handbags
- No false/polished nails
- No false eyelashes
- No jewellery worn
- No smart watches
- No make up

All skirts must be knee length and must not be rolled up.

Mobile phones are not allowed to be seen or used in school. If a student has a mobile phone, it must always be switched off and out of sight. Phones that are heard or seen will be confiscated and stored safely and only returned when a parent/carer collects it from school.

Earrings, nose rings etc are not allowed in school. Any jewellery seen will be confiscated and stored safely and only returned when a parent/carer collects it from school. Hairbrushes must be out of sight and must not be used in classrooms or communal areas.

If your child is having a piercing done over summer, ensure that it is done at the start of the holidays so there is enough time for healing. Getting a piercing done towards the end of the holidays will not be accepted as an excuse to wear jewellery in school.
