Dear Parent / Carer

It is that time of year when we start to plan the Year 11 prom which is a very exciting event allowing students and staff to say farewell to each other. To keep students motivated and on track for the best GCSE grades, and as part of the end of year celebrations, it is with great pleasure that we announce the details of this year's event.

The prom will take place at Aintree Racecourse on Thursday 25th June 2026 (7pm-11pm) in the Papillion Suite.

To attend the evening, students must meet the following criteria:

- Have good or improved attendance and punctuality.
- Have good behaviour, following the Kirkby Code – if a student receives a suspension from school, they will not be permitted to attend prom.
- Attend additional revision sessions that are on offer to support progress towards GCSE examinations.

If your child has a major school incident between now and the prom, they may lose their prom place and forfeit their deposit.

The cost of our prom ticket will be £67 per student. The ticket cost may be reduced following planned fundraising activities. This will cover the cost of the following:

- Venue hire
- Red carpet arrival
- Mocktail on arrival
- Two course buffet dinner
- DJ and light up dance floor
- Table arrangements and decorations
- Other entertainment on the evening
- Coach travel to and from the venue

A non-refundable deposit of £16 must be paid by Friday 9th January 2026. If you would like to pay the full balance this is also possible. This can be made on Arbor or payable in cash at reception. A payment plan is also available. If there is an issue with making a payment, please contact us at school.

Instalments must be paid by the following dates:

- £16.00 deposit by Friday 9th January 2026
- £17.00 by Friday 13th February 2026
- £17.00 by Friday 13th March 2026
- £17.00 by Tuesday 14th April 2026

All monies are to be paid into reception during the following days of the week and times -
Weekdays: Before School-8-8.40am/After school- 3.10pm at reception or on Arbor.
