KS3 Attainment Banding

Please see the table below for information regarding your child's attainment banding. Where KS2 data is available, an average of the reading and maths score has been used to work out an attainment band. The final column relates the attainment banding to a range of expected GCSE grades.

KS2 average in reading and maths	Attainment Banding	GCSE Forecast
Greater than or equal to 110	Above (A)	Grades 7 - 9
Greater than or equal to 100 but less than 110	Expected (E)	Grades 4 – 6+
Below 100	Working Towards (WT)	Grades 1 – 3+

The +/-/- grading shows how secure students are with the assessment criteria within their attainment band.

+/=/-	Definition
+	Means they are secure in most (or all) of the assessment criteria within that banding
=	Means they are secure in some of the assessment criteria within that banding
-	Means they are starting to access the assessment criteria within that banding
